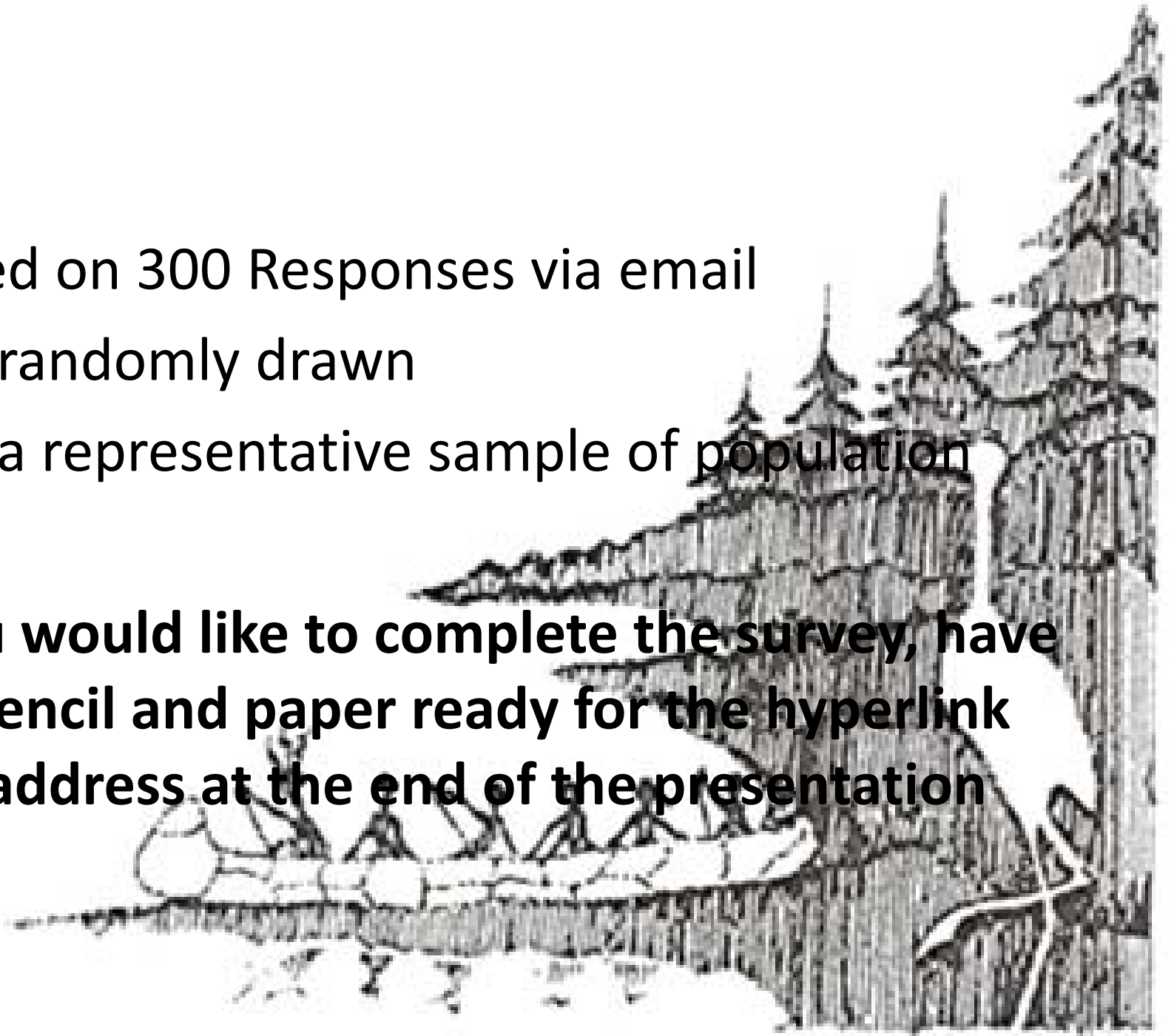

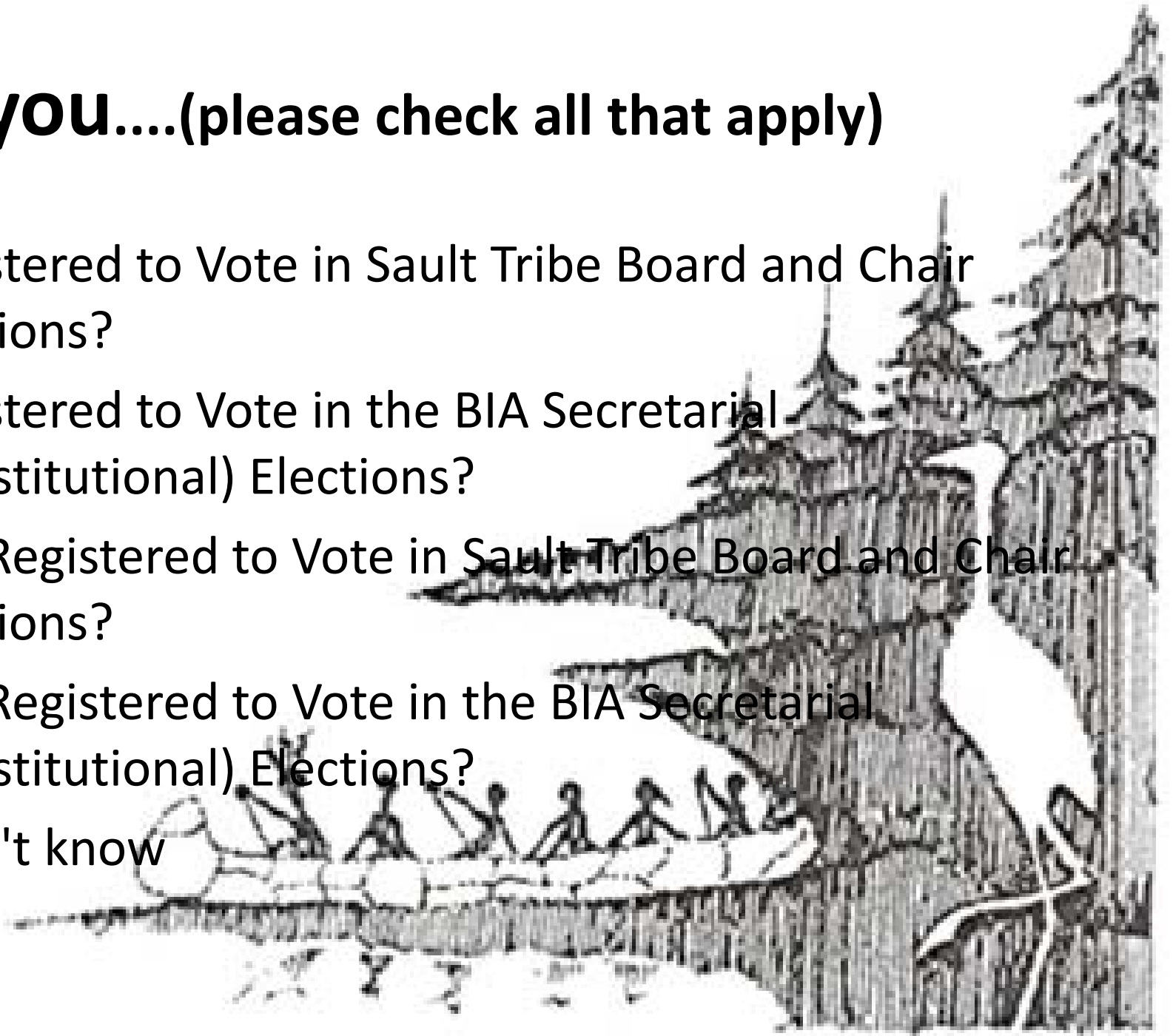
- Based on 300 Responses via email

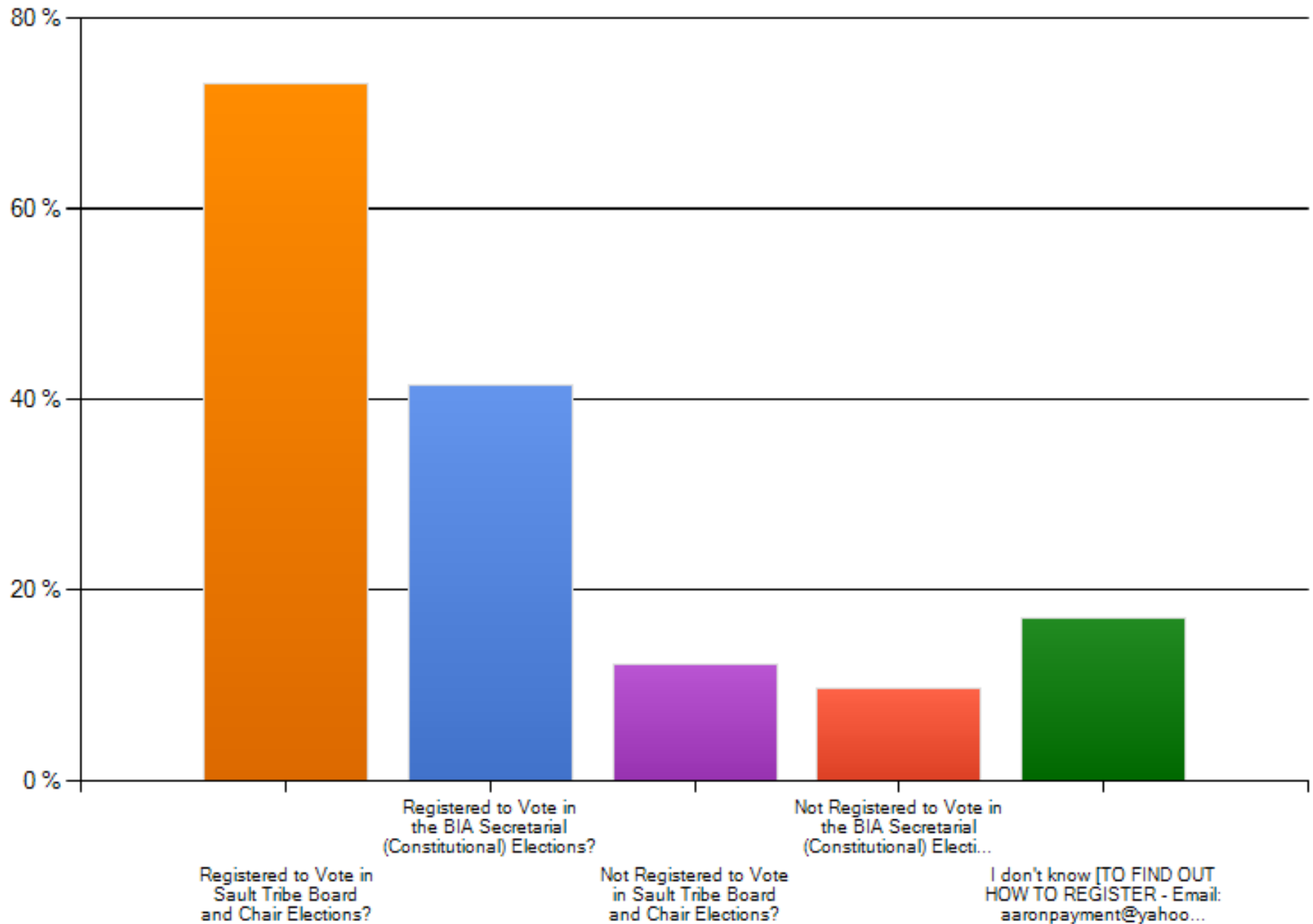

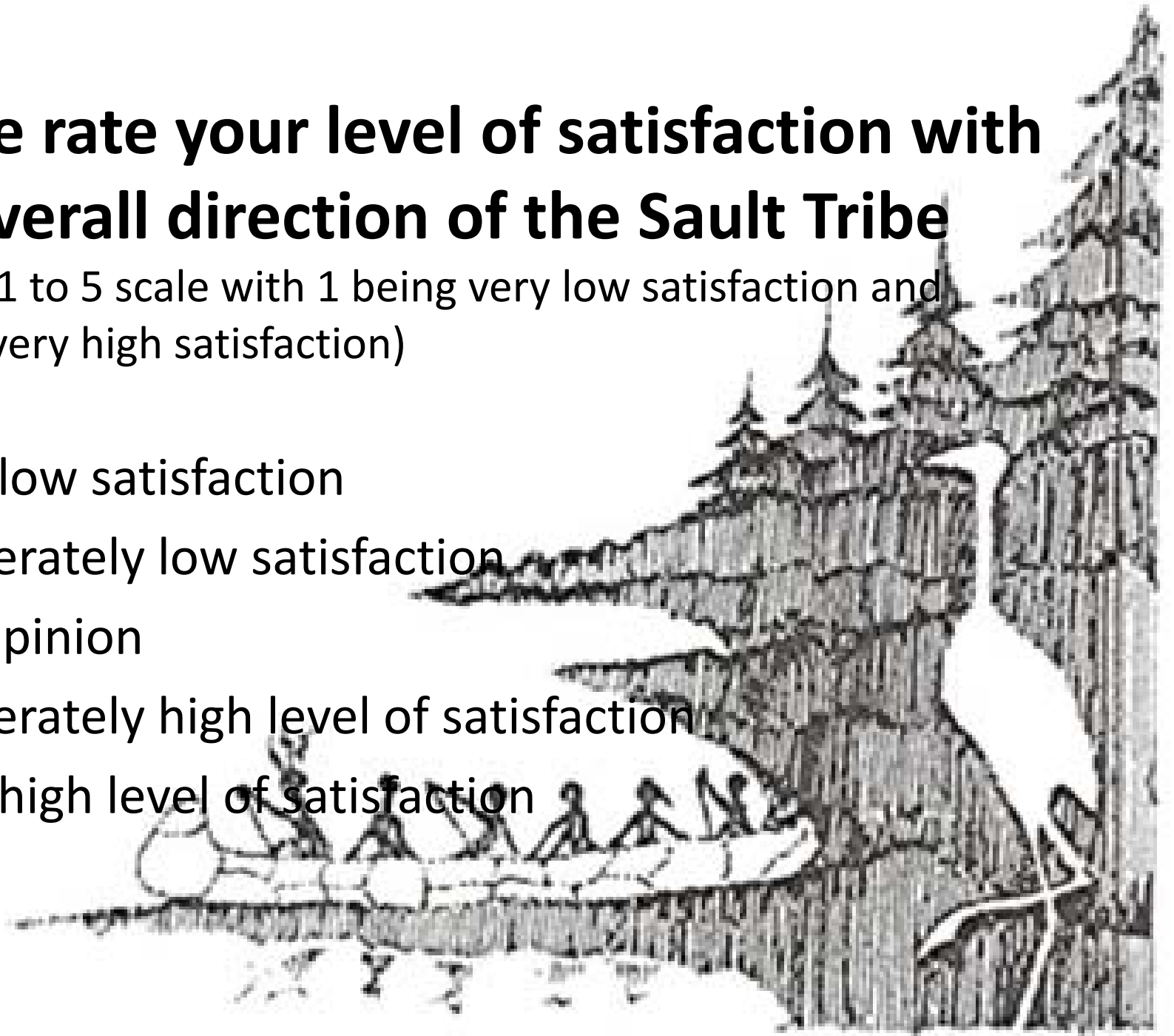

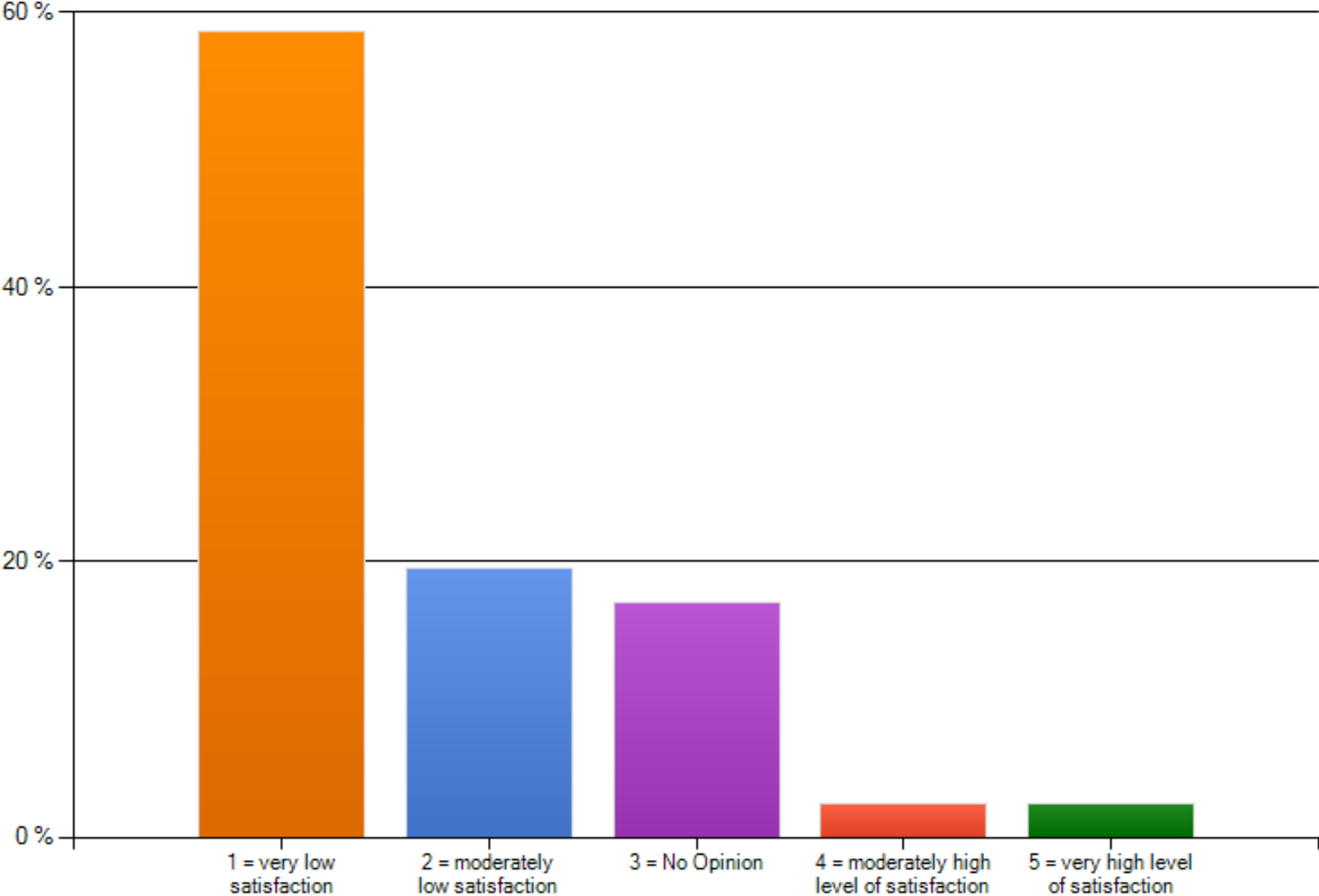
# Please rate your level of satisfaction with the overall direction of the Sault Tribe

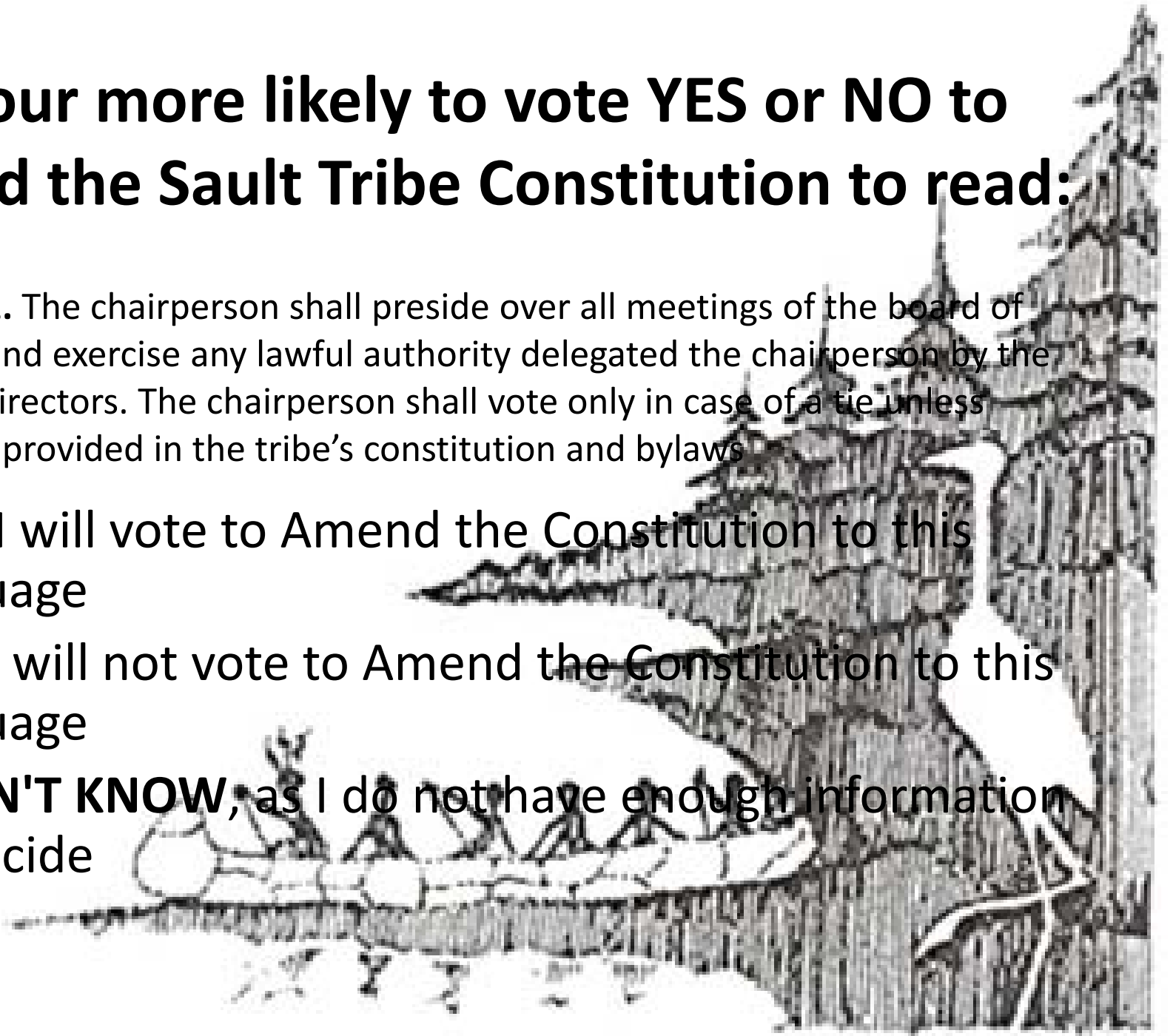
